## Emergency & Level II Trauma Services

When seconds count, Cabell Huntington Hospital is prepared, with one of the most advanced emergency and trauma centers in the region. The country's first Level II joint trauma center is staffed around the clock with physician specialists, anesthesiologists and surgeons ready for any emergency. The staff works hard to ensure that patients receive lifesaving medical care quickly and effectively.

Cabell Huntington Hospital is just minutes from I-64 and can be easily reached by ambulance or helicopter. Through radio communication with the hospital, a specially trained trauma team is prepared and ready to care for the incoming patient.



To better serve our patients, the Emergency Department has been renovated and expanded, with a large, comfortable waiting area, 30 exam rooms and five trauma rooms.

Not every patient who is treated in the Emergency Department is admitted. Sometimes, patients can be treated and discharged, either to their homes or back to the hospital from which they were transferred.

**Visiting hours:** Visitors are welcome to stay with the patient. In the evening, visitors must have visitors' passes, which are distributed by the Security staff.
